## SPECIAL TOWN BUDGET MEETING May 24, 2012

First Selectman Edward Haberek, Jr. called the Special Town Budget Meeting of the Town of Stonington to order at 7:03 p.m. on May 24, 2012 at the Stonington High School auditorium. In attendance were First Selectman Edward Haberek, Jr., Selectmen George Crouse and Glee McAnanly.

Mr. Bill Sternberg nominated Mr. James O'Boyle as Moderator being properly seconded and being no objections Mr. O'Boyle was unanimously elected Moderator of the meeting, and Kris Bell served as clerk.

There being no objection, the Moderator dispensed with reading the Call recorded immediately preceding these pages and asked for a resolution on the first item on the Call.

First Selectman Haberek moved and read the following resolution:
