Regular Meeting - October 23, 2012

A Regular Meeting of the Water Pollution Control Authority was held October 23, 2012, at the Stonington Police Station Meeting Room.

- 1. Chairman Sisk called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
- 2. Fire Exit Plan

R. Cody presented motion to move agenda items requiring action by the Board to next on the agenda to accommodate member quorum vote and allow subsequent departure of Mr. Cody. Agenda change moves Item #6 (Bill Payment), Item #10 (Sept. 25, 2012 Minutes approval) and one item of the Directors Report (authorization for contract for Pump Station #3 UST removal) to next on the agenda.

R. Cody moved to change agenda sequence. P. Balestracci seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

- 8. Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements

Representing CDM Smith and CDM Constructors Inc: P. Hughes, R. Blake and B. Benoit Comments additional to submitted report:

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- Procurement of several key items completed (BioMag, turbo blowers, biomag building, switchgear, generator), and several key items still under review (UV equipment, screenings/grit/grease system).
- With the protracted UV system procurement, the UV installation at the Boro and Pawcatuck plants may have slipped a few months and schedule is to be reviewed with WPCA and UW.
- Turbo blower installation at the Boro is still scheduled for late 1stQ of 2013 in advance of diversion flow from Mystic to the Boro.

 One student member of the audience asked for an explanation of the term "UV" and
 Chairman Sisk reviewed the current hypochlorite disinfection method and upgrade to
 ultraviolet disinfection.
