Fire Station/Community Center Renovation Project – Special Town Meeting Warrant Article 1

- Mr. Martin and Mr. Landry presented an overview of the Project, including pertinent details that had been developed during the design development phase of the effort.
- Mr. Landry stated that the Fire Station portion of the project meets the needs of the Town's Fire Department, even though some of the design dimensions are different than industry standards.
- Details of the project that were discussed included: traffic patterns, septic system upgrades, water supply, building heating and ventilation, snow removal, seismic requirements, fire protection, emergency electric generation capability, fuel oil storage, and the capacity of the facility to be used as a community shelter during emergencies.
- Ross Perry introduced a motion for the Capital Planning Committee to recommend the Town support the Project. Charles Kern seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.
