Where would you rather walk? Here...

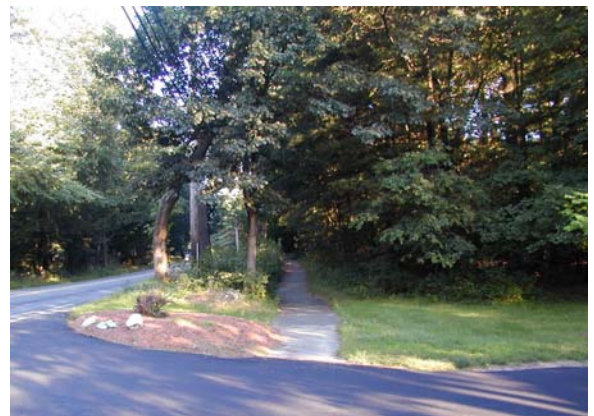
The workshop consists of a presentation, a community “walking audit,” and a follow-up session for brainstorming possible options for improvements.
