#### **MINUTES**

#### **ACTION ITEMS**

<u>River Hill Estates Subdivision</u> – Members will ask Planning Coordinator Karen Kelleher to follow up on the following issues to be addressed during the public hearing process:

- Can the Board approve a public way off of a private way?
- Can the property owner remove only a portion of the parcel from Chapter 61B?

<u>Presti Property</u> - Members will ask Planning Coordinator Karen Kelleher to follow up on the Zoning Board Appeals Decision to determine if they approved a Special Permit for used-car lots.

## **ANR PLAN - Boxboro Road**

Members reviewed an ANR Plan for the Minute Man Realty Corp. property off of Boxborough Road.

Kathleen Willis moved to request the following modifications and to authorize Malcolm FitzPatrick or Karen Kelleher to endorse a revised plan with the required changes.

- Note 6 on Plan should read: This plan is meant and intended to define the property line of Parcels B-3 and B-4. Also to remove the boundry (should be spelled boundary) lines of Lots B-1 and B-2, both of which will become part of Parcel B-3.
- The Board agreed to waive the requirement of Section 2.1.2.12 of the Subdivision Rules (location of wells and septic systems of abutters)
- The following note should be added to the plan as required by Section 2.1.2.15 of the Subdivision Rules: "This plan is meant and intended to supercede all plans which predate the endorsement."

The motion was seconded by Malcolm FitzPatrick and carried by a unanimous vote of three members present (Ernie Dodd, Malcolm FitzPatrick and Kathleen Willis).

## **SPECIAL TOWN MEETING**

#### MEADOWBROOK ESTATES SUBDIVISION (TREFRY LANE)
