PROPOSED ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENTS

Members reviewed the draft Zoning Bylaw Amendments dated February 22, 2007 and further amendments discussed at the meeting of February 28, 2007.

Exemptions – Religious, Educational, Agricultural or Municipal Uses Malcolm FitzPatrick suggested moving Section 9.9 - Religious, Educational, Agricultural or Municipal Uses to Section 3.9 - Non-Conforming Uses and Structures. Members disagreed with his interpretation that those uses and structures are "non-conforming".

Bed and Breakfast – Malcolm FitzPatrick objected to the proposal to remove the requirement for Bed and Breakfast Establishments to be owner occupied and require a fulltime manager onsite.

Members agreed to bring forth the following changes to the Annual Town Meeting and request that the Board of Selectmen commit to a Fall Special Town Meeting for the remaining articles.

Definitions:

- Bed and Breakfast Home
- Bed and Breakfast Establishment
- Assisted Living Residence

Overlay Districts:

- Move Section 5.3 Wireless Service Facility to Section 3.11 (Overlay Districts)
- Move Section 5.4 Active Adult Neightbood to Section 3.11 (Overlay Districts)

Lighting Bylaw – Proposed changes recommended by the Light Pollution SubCommittee.
