Minutes

Phil Moseley moved to approve minutes of the September 8, 2010 meeting, as amended. The motion was seconded by Russ Willis and carried by a unanimous vote of six members present (Don McPherson, Phil Moseley, Russ Willis, Barbara Sipler, Brian Martinson and Karen Kelleher).

Gateway Sign

Barbara Sipler shared sample gateway signs for committee input. Some of the samples included language indicating that Stow is a Farm Friendly Community. Members agreed that the sign should be Lower Village Specific. Language should be "Welcome to Stow Lower Village" and should include a historic image of Lower Village.

Streetscape – Fence and Trees

Members reviewed a sketch plan prepared by Don McPherson, which includes fence and tree locations. Members agreed that fencing should be placed in groupings of three to five sections so with a tree planted between each section. Trees should be planted 15' from the curb cut and there should be an eight-foot break between the fence and tree. Karen Kelleher and Kristen Domurad will work on a visual using GIS.

Fencing

Phil Moseley noted that the Town still has \$1,200.00 from Faxon Farm for fencing, which could buy approximately 10 posts. It was suggested that fencing be installed at the pedestrian path between Bradley Lane and Stow Travel.

Traffic Island

Don McPherson agreed to send a letter to Mike Clayton asking him to:

Locate Great Road Right of Way Bounds

Mowing town land between Red Acre Road and Pompositticut Street

Installation of Traffic Islands.
