

MINUTES
ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS
AUGUST 31, 2015

The meeting was held in Stow Town Building and opened at 7:05 p.m. Board members present were Edmund Tarnuzzer, Charles Barney, William Byron, Bruce Fletcher and Mark Jones.

The Collings Foundation – Robert & Caroline Collings: Chairman Tarnuzzer announced the purpose of the meeting was to consider the decision as crafted by Town Counsel Barbara Huggins regarding the Appeals from Unfavorable Action of the Building Commissioner filed by the applicants. One concerned the denial of a request for reconsideration of a cease and desist order and the other denial of a request for stay of the cease and desist, both related to the existing airport and landing field at 137 Barton Road. The hearing on the appeals had opened on July 6th, continued to July 13th and 20th and closed on August 3rd. The Board voted four to one on August 3rd to uphold the action of the Building Commissioner in both denials.

The decision on the two appeals was included in a single document, and a copy will be filed with the Town Clerk in the each of the two separate files. There was no comment from the members. They then proceeded to sign the signature pages.

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
