

**STAR TOWER CO./T-MOBILE NORTHEAST
PETITION FOR VARIANCE
NOVEMBER 15, 2010 (Continued Hearing)**

The public hearing continued from October 25 and November 1, 2010 was reopened in Stow Town Building at 7:30 p.m. on the petition filed by **Star Tower Co., LLC, 655 Summer Street, Boston and T-Mobile Northeast LL, 15 Commerce Way, Norton** for variances under Zoning Bylaw Sections 3.10, 5.3.7.1, 5.3.7.2 and 5.3.8 to allow construction of a wireless service facility at **215 Harvard Road (Wedgewood Pines Country Club)**. The property is shown on Stow Property Map R-4 as Parcel 39A.

The report of David Maxson of Isotrope, LLC, RF engineer consultant for the Board, had been received late last week with no opportunity for review by the Board, the applicant or Town Counsel.
