Mail Items

- An invoice was received from the Sykas law office for \$405 re: the Vi Roberts easement; its payment has already been authorized.
- An invoice for \$123.70 was received for recording the deeds for the Vi Roberts easement; its payment has already been authorized.
- An invoice was received from the Southeast Land Trust for \$13,876.20 re: the Vi Roberts easement; its payment has already been authorized. The amount includes billing for staff hours, long term monitoring, a hazard waste report, survey and attorney fees.

Planning Board Updates

- The board is work shopping potential zoning amendments for the coming year.
- Kirk Scamman submitted a site plan application for the parking pad across from Frying Pan Lane

Easement Updates

- The Goodrich easement was reviewed with Pat and the selectmen; small changes were made.
- The first draft of the Jones easement has been circulated for review. A decision was made to put the owner's 5 acre lot at the corner of Winnicutt and High Streets. An environmental review showed a farm dump on site as well as an abandoned well; the latter may be on adjacent property (will know following survey).

Caroline Robinson Display

 Donna has spoken with the Portsmouth Sign Company about a wood plaque with a metal plate. A 9x12" size would be approximately \$50. Donna and Pat, via Edie, have sent potential wording to Caroline's children. Leslie (librarian) will organize the books once the display is created.
