*Bunker Hill Subdivision*

- *Minutes on the Bunker Hill subdivision were recorded by the Planning Board. Of specific note, CC requested that the developer add to covenants that no additional pavement, sheds or pools be allowed to be added to individual lots. The CC also was not interested in paved parking on the roadway next to the ball fields; members felt it was not a good idea and would only increase impervious surface and encourage parking in other areas along the roadway.*

*Unitil*

- Unitil will be re-laying pipeline starting in July, per government regulations. It will affect two miles, 14 wetland crossings, 19 properties, one vernal pool.
- Patty Quinn of Unitil will be asked to attend the next meeting.

*Other*

- Allison motioned, Bob seconded a motion to pay Pat \$57.19 for donuts and water purchased for the town clean-up day. The motion passed unanimously.
- Donna will complete paperwork for Litter Free New Hampshire
- One compost bin will be left for show in the Town Hall
