**Great Bay Discovery Center**

Cory Riley from the Great Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve provided Allison Knab and the conservation commission with its draft NHDES wetland permit by email. The GBNER will be replacing the existing boardwalk but must submit a "minimum impact" wetland permit.

Cory Riley had a number of questions for Allison as well.

**Municipal Updates**

Rollins Farm Development continues to work with Lincoln Daley to create a draft operation and management plan for Planning Board approval. This may potentially be before the commission at the next scheduled meeting.

Lincoln Daley communicated to Allison that the town is considering putting a Verizon cell phone tower on the town property purchased for a water tower adjacent to 28 Bunker Hill Avenue (2013 Makris development). Trees may need to be cut in the cluster development open space to possibly create an access tower road.

Allison Knab will speak to Paul Deschaine regarding the education of residents on the new recycling services offered by Casella Waste Management. The commission would like for a company representative to attend a meeting to discuss recycling in town.

At 7:24pm Bill McCarthy moved and Tim Copeland seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed.
