Winter Public Program: Members present decided to plan a February program featuring objects that tell (and evoke) stories about the history of the town and its evolution. Linda Wilson, recently retired from the DHR, was proposed as a moderator and commenter.

Town Center Charrette: There was a discussion of the recent Plan NH Town Center charrette. Rebecca noted that both the Plan NH experts and community participants acknowledged that the historic features of the Town Center make a positive contribution to the area's potential development. MJ Werner stressed that kudos were due to the members of the Town Center Committee as much of what was proposed by the Plan NH team had been proposed in past work of the committee. The Commission's Town Center display will be mounted on the Planning bulletin board at the Municipal Center.
