

**Water Commission Meeting
February 4, 2003**

Called to order @ 7:35 p.m.

Reviewed minutes of last month's Commission meeting held on January 7th. Motion to approve the minutes was passed.

Activity:

- George reviewed the Dearborn Brook Watershed project. Explained the layout of the map depicting all area water supplies. Besides the Dearborn Brook Watershed, the Skinner Spring Wells are also a significant supplier of water to Exeter (10% of their water). The Dearborn Watershed supplies approximately 90% of Exeter's water.
- On February 19, 2003 there will be a Planning Board meeting, during which a presentation will be made by the Exeter Water Commission to educate everyone on where the Watershed resides, and how we are planning to protect the resource. This will include conservation of wetlands and environmental issues. Additionally, we will bring all of the critical bodies together to ensure that we begin to align perceptions and objectives and work together toward our common goal.

Action Items:

- Jeremy still needs to have contact with Aquarion to get some guidance as to how to estimate the water usage demands of an auto dealer.
- Survey data disks due to George next meeting.
