## **Old Business**

Discussed Clause 56. PM made a motion to define the criteria of the approved motion of 4/14/2014. The criteria for military tax exemptions will be that exemptions will apply to primary residences only. An exemption can be up to \$750. BL mentioned that fully disabled veterans are allowed an exemption of up to \$1,000. The exemption will be available for those on active duty service in a foreign country. The exemption will not be retroactive to earlier service. It was also noted that this exemption applies only to members of the Massachusetts National Guard and Reservists as state law does not allow the offering of such an exemption for other service people.
