Re: Health Agent's report

- Routine inspections and reviews;
- Percolation test season, (new) closed (fully subscribed through May 28, 2010);
- Follow-up, well issues at 9 Hamilton Rd (plan received) permit issued; 58 South Shore Rd. existing well to be de-commissioned and new well to be drilled;
- Inspections with Ron, Oxhead Tavern – corrections required;
- New tanning facility, Modello's – permit issued;
- Beaver complaint – 42 Tantasqua Shore Rd., inspected (DENIED, not a public health interest, refer to Div of Fish & Wildlife);
