Committee Updates

- Richard Paradise from Trails Committee stated that a TC meeting was held 1/12/12 and provided an update to the Commission

Opacum Land Trust to discuss Hein's Farm Conservation Restriction:

- Don Miller asked Jennifer Ohop, President of Opacum Land Trust how the amount of an endowment is determined.
- JO stated the amount of the endowment is determined on a case by case basis. JO stated that volunteers are used for monitoring. JO suggested if there are certain issues such as no hunting on the property she suggested not putting it in the CR but include it in the rules and regulations.
- EJ suggested a meeting with Opacum to come in and start drafting something for the Commission to consider.

7:30 p.m. Public Hearing (Public Hearing to open January 19, 2012) DEP #300-780 Amended Notice of Intent Application submitted by the Town of Sturbridge for

construction/reconstruction of footbridges, invasive species treatment/removal, trail maintenance and improvement at 10 Shattuck Road/1 Old Sturbridge Village Road and 197 Leadmine Road.

Meeting opened @ 8:37p.m.

- TC stated part of Bridge #4 is not supported and is proposing to remove the tailrace and fill the area to complete the trail.
- JB asked the amount of fill being proposed.
- TC stated because of the CR on the property he is proposing using about 6-8 cubic yards of fill from the gravel pit.
- TC stated this will be a gradual slope with top soil and seed.
- JB asked once the area is filled what the slope will be.
- TC stated the slope can be 3 to 1 if that's what the Commission would like.
- Bob Briere stated he is not in favor of filling in the tailrace.
- Randy Redetzke (not signed in) asked if the tail end of the tailrace is filled in.
- TC stated no.
- DB suggested a site visit.
- TC listed the items that still need attention are: cleaning of the culverts, treatment of Phragmites, remove material from the channel, repair of sink holes, exploratory excavation, crossing C (proposing a 3' diameter culvert) and crossing D (proposal of a stream crossing).
- DB asked that the channel be cleaned during dry conditions in August.

Tannery Road/Tall Pines Update:

Wells State Park Culvert Replacement-National Grid:

Letter Permits

479 Main Street-Tree Removal Permit:

- CM stated that he and JK went out to look at the site and suggested the trees still standing be pruned with the exception of one of those trees needing to come down. CM stated 14-15 trees have already been cut into the wetland and his opinion is that the area will re-vegetate.
- EJ asked that the tree to come down be flagged by CM or JK. EJ stated she is concerned with the felled trees being perpendicular to the flow of the water and suggested that they be removed from the property.

Consensus by the Commission to approve one tree (to be flagged by a Commission member) by the building to come down and the rest of the trees along the building be pruned; the trees that were previously cut and felled into the wetland are to be removed and carried off the property by hand by 2/15/12.

17 Evergreen Lane:

- EJ stated this is a request for a proposed sun porch on an existing deck on site and the extending of 2 open decks. EJ stated the proposed work will require 9 new pier footings on sonotubes and excavation will be dug by hand with any excess material required for back fill removed from the site.
- DB suggested gravel be placed underneath the area.
