7:00 PM-Open Meeting - Quorum check As time allows

CPA, PLAC and Lakes Advisory Committee update(s)

Walk-ins:

Peter Mimeault-76 South Shore Drive-DEP #300-751:

- PM read his narrative regarding minor amendments to DEP #300-751 which are;
- 1. Modifying an existing swale along the upland side of South Shore Drive.
- 2. Orienting the driveway as it relates to the gravel road.
- 3. Changes in the design within the Right of Way to include about 10' of pavers and cobblestone to transition from gravel to a paved surface.
- 4. Modifying the landscaping and positioning of the proposed garage.
- EJ asked PM when the work would start if the swale associated with the roadway is approved.
- PM stated asap.
- EG questioned whether the changes were minor and wants time to review them, hear comments from Greg (DPW) and do a site visit.

MOTION: By DB, seconded by DG to approve the driveway and garage modifications.

Vote: 2/1 opposed by EG. 1 abstention by WLH. Dave Holdcraft-South Shore Drive/44 Allen Road:

- DH asked the next time the Commission goes on his property they get permission from him.
- DB stated it was an error on his part; he had intended to get back to DH regarding the timing of the Emergency site visit.

<u>7:30 p.m. Public Hearing</u> – (Public Hearing to open May 3, 2012) Notice of Intent application submitted by Roux Associates, Inc. on behalf of Exxon Mobil Pipeline Company for preventative maintenance of petroleum pipeline at 117 McGilpin Road.

• Jim Dick from Roux Associates, Inc. showed the area of proposed work.

MOTION: By DB, seconded by WLH to approve with the same Order of Conditions as previously given.

Vote: 3/0. EG recused himself.

<u>7: 45 p.m. Public Hearing</u> – (Public Hearing opened April 19, 2012) After the fact Request for Determination of Applicability submitted by Randy Bercume to determine whether work to construct a shed at 11 Draper Woods Road is subject to the Wetlands Protection Act and Local Wetlands Bylaw and Regulations.

• EJ stated she has asked for comments from the Building Inspector and hasn't received any as of tonight. EJ asked that the homeowner seed and stabilize the soil areas.

MOTION: By DB, seconded by EG to issue a negative determination under the WPA. Vote: 3/0.

1 abstention by WLH.

• DB suggested the homeowner use an organic fertilizer such as Milorganite.

MOTION: By DB, seconded by DG to issue a positive determination under the local bylaw.

Vote: 3/0. 1 abstention by WLH. **8:00 p.m. Public Hearing** – (Public Hearing opened April 19, 2012) Notice of Intent application submitted by Bertin Engineering on behalf of Edward Moore for conversion of a deck into a 3 season room and redesign of a deck at 18 Birch Street.

- ML presented the proposed work and stated there is very little soil disturbance and will hand dig sonotubes.
- EG asked what the distance of the 2' cantilevered section is to the water.
- ML stated the distance to the water is 30.5'.
- EJ recommended armoring on the North side of the garage and tie in the downspouts on other areas of the house to the infiltration chamber (garage) and asked ML where the downspouts from the garage discharge to.
- Pat Wondolowski (an abutter) stated the downspouts discharge water onto her property and then discharges into the lake.
- ML stated the stone area can be pitched along the deck towards the front into the dispersant area under the deck.
- EJ suggested the downspout be redirected and the pipe that sends water into the lake be disconnected and redirected toward the stone area.
- DG stated she would like a site visit.
- DB asked ML that the area of construction be staked.

Public Hearing continued to 5/17/12 @ 8:00 p.m.

- EG asked for additional plans in regards to the sloping of the roof.
- ML showed plans of the proposed roof line and stated the gutters will direct the water under the deck.

8:15 p.m. Public Hearing – (Public Hearing opened April 19, 2012) Notice of Intent application submitted by Green Hill Engineering on behalf of Bruce & Bernice Hartwick to install a 2,000 gallon holding tank, abandonment of existing septic system, drilling of a new well, jacking up the house and pouring of a new concrete foundation at 62 Bullough Road.

- Mark Farrell from Green Hill Engineering presented the plans to the Commission and stated this is a proposal to replace the existing septic system with a 2,000 gallon holding tank in between the road and the home and a drilled well. MF also proposed to install Piers 4' deep so the house will sit 2' higher. MF stated an old leach field area is proposed as a dewatering area.
- EJ suggested a ring of 8 staked hay bales lined with filter fabric.

- Mr. Kady stated that grading will stay the same with a proposal of 16 footings under the home. Mr. Kady stated some of the spoils from excavation of the Piers will be stock piled during construction.
- DB stated everything needs to be covered.
- DG asked if any trees are proposed to be removed.
- Mr. Kady stated no trees are proposed to be removed.

MOTION: By DG, seconded by EG to approve with the Agents comments regarding stock piling and dewatering.

Vote: 3/0. 1 abstention by WLH.

Water Works Drive-Truck Roll Over(Emergency Response investigation of possible spill)-Drafted:

• EJ stated this is to seek an Emergency Certificate with the start date of 5/8/2012-6/7/2012 to sample soils in regards to a truck roll over. EJ suggested installing erosion controls to stabilize.
