<u>62 Mt. Dan Road: Peter Levesque- discussion regarding a proposed project at 62 Mt. Dan Road.</u>

- Peter Levesque from Pioneer Environmental, Inc. stated he met with DB and the Town Planner previously regarding this proposed project at 62 Mt. Dan Road and is here tonight looking for feedback from the Commission regarding the 50' no structure.
