DRC Comments/Conditions: Mr. Tang was informed of the proper sequence of a landscape plan, i.e. plan to be presented for approval before installation. He now understands the process. During discussion, he was assured he can open his business without delay with the current plantings in place but is to return with a landscape plan for approval before installing any more plantings. The committee made suggestions to enhance his property such as hiding the trash receptacles from public view checking with the Planning Department for regulations pertaining to such. Discussion also centered on seating outside with tables, umbrellas, additional landscaping in planters to enhance the outside areas.

Mr. Tang was instructed to return to DRC at our August meeting with a new landscape plan.
