The total amount is close to \$1.374 million; 75% of which will be reimbursed by FEMA. RV thinks the time period is short, KS think it is two years. KS would like clarification from Barbara Barry (BB) and Shaun Suhoski, suggests a Saturday morning meeting with BOS and BB. PA makes a motion to take no action, seconded by RV. Vote 7-0-0.
