WAIVER OF SITE PLAN – SETH LAJOIE REPRESENTING EXXON/MOBIL TO RELOCATE PIPELINE AT THE PICADILLY PUB @ 362 MAIN STREET

Mr. Lajoie spoke on behalf of the applicant. He stated that a new pipeline is to be laid on the outer perimeter of the parking. To reduce the number of open holes, the pipeline will be installed in sections. Nothing on the ground will be changed.

Mr. Lajoie questioned Condition # 5. Once the line is in place, it must be hydro tested and that can take from 8 to 36 hours. Limiting construction work times could hinder the testing.

The Board also agreed to add Condition #10 – Work shall not occur during the PanMass Challenge.
