DISCUSS DEVELOPING AN IMPLEMENATION PLAN FOR THE COMMERCIAL TOURIST DISTRICT REVITALIZATION PLAN

Ms. Gibson-Quigley asked the Board how they want to approach this plan and how to implement it.

Mr. Cunniff stated that maybe it would be best to wait on implementing this study until the Master Plan is finished.

Ms. Bubon stated that this is a Planning Board document and CMRPC has worked with VHB and Pachard, who are working on the Design Review Guideline Handbook, and has incorporated their ideas into this plan.

The Board decided that this will be a great planning tool and to begin prioritizing and assigning the various tasks associated with each defined goal.

The Board decided to go through each goal on the plan identified as a planning issue and decide what can be now and versus the future.

Goal 1 – Facilitate walkability. Expand and Improve sidewalks of Route 20 along the entire Commercial Tourist District Corridor. This goal is the most difficult and will take the longest.

Goal 2 – Implement traffic calming measures to reduce speeds and increase predictability with regard to turning movements.

Goal 4 – Develop public parking spaces in this District to encourage walking between various areas of shops and restaurant.

Goal 6 – Facilitate the development/redevelopment of vacant or underutilized properties to enhance this District's draw as a commercial center.

Goal 7 – Encourage attractive, effective signage throughout the CT District that is consistent with a unifying New England village theme in design and size that is readable by passing motorist.

Goal 8 – Facilitate development and redevelopment that is consistent with a unifying design theme for architecture/building facades of new or expanded structures and site design.

Timeframe - Start working in June, July & August

in order to make changes to the zoning bylaw for the Annual Town Meeting 2011

Goal 9 – Create a physical and conceptual connection between the Commercial Tourist District and the Quinebaug River, nearby ponds and trails.

Partners – Business owners – Conservation Commission

9. B – Project Lead – Planning – Trails Committee

9. C – Project Lead – Planning – Lakes Advisory Committee
