The Forestry Management Plans for the Town of Sunapee properties will be delayed due to the Forester Laura French will be having knee surgery.

Field Stone Hill – the right of way hammerhead has signage posted by abutters. There is a 50' right of way that is open and in the subdivision survey. SCC will inquire on the lower parcel availability and price in the subdivision. There is a parcel land locked this purchase could open access.

Van Webb will pursue the Dewey Woods vegetation “clean up” on the banking of Rt 11.
