There have been many groups involved in the preservation and planning of the future use of this landmark for the town. Sunapee Harbor Riverway (SHRC), Harbor House Livery (HHL), Sunapee Heritage Alliance (SHA), Town of Sunapee. The Riverway would like to take ownership of the building. They have designed a few potential plans for the property. There would be covenants in place prior to the transfer. Easements in the deed would be in place for the River walk, maintenance of the damn, the bridge landing property, maintenance to maintain the ramp, doors, clock with cupola. This agreement would guarantee public access. The property consists of the foot print of the Livery building then the land from the livery building to the insurance office. All proposed renovations will meet all shoreline protection act requirements. Tim Fleury made the motion to recommend that the Select Board of the Town of Sunapee make the transfer of the Livery Building to the Sunapee Harbor Riverway Corporation for the sum of \$1.00 (One Dollar).
