

**SUNAPEE FIRE DEPARTMENT

July 9, 2018

D Ruggles called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Present were: Dan Ruggles, Dana Ramspott, Howard Sargent and Mark Scott.

H Sargent made a motion and it was seconded by M Scott to approve the minutes of June 11, 2018.

M Scott made a motion and it was seconded by D Ramspott to approve the non-public minutes of June 11, 2018.

D Ruggles reported on the following:

- Front and side doors are unlocked for the Board of Engineers Meeting.
- The new compressor is complete. The cost for the Electrician was \$306 and the air samples were satisfactory.
- There will be a mandatory department Traffic Control Class July 10, 2018.
- The training with the tour boats went well. There was a suggestion that we try it at night time. Many different agencies around the area participated.
- The dry hydrant is in Bradford Rd.
- Once again it was another successful 4th of July with all the activities.
- Janet McAlister will produce the original decree that bequeaths some of her brother's estate to the Sunapee Fire Department so that this can move forward with this endeavor.
- Tablets in the trucks are all working with the exception of Engine 2.
- The total grant we received was ~~\$57,700~~ and to date we have spent \$54,300.

- Newbury needs the assistance of our boat for fireworks detail on Saturday, July 14th.
- A foot race on July 14th in Webb's Forest.
- A bike race on July 15th in Webb's Forest.
- Coffee with the Chief on July 15th where the Fire Boat along with the Police Boat will be on exhibit. New Hampshire Marine Patrol will be the guest speaker.

- There will be training on July 21st at David Bailey's house on Young Hill Road at 8:30am.

Both the Fire & Police Chiefs met with Tony Venti from Sunapee Cove regarding active shooter in the building training. This will also include a mass evacuation of building and the plan is to bring everyone to the Safety Services Building. This will coincide with a state mandate for this type of training.

D Ruggles will be on vacation July 27-Aug 5th.


There will be a short meeting tomorrow night to vote on two new members.


D Ramspott made a motion and it was seconded by M Scott to adjourn 7:17pm.
