Jean, I want to send this email to outline what we spoke about. You wish to hold an art show and we agreed the place to have it is the greenway in Sunapee Harbor next to the Towns bathrooms. You will line the artists tents along the tree line which abuts 15 Lake Ave. and along the edge of Lake Ave as well. You will check with River to use their property in front of the stores.

For delivery your artist may park on Lake Ave to unload and pick only and this should be quick as possible once the vehicle is unloaded the vehicle should then be moved. I will set out cones on Lake Ave for artist to park between, if there is no room then artist will have to wait until there is room. Parking to load/unload will only be on one side. Parking for artists will be River Road as any spots in Sunapee harbor are time sensitive and should be left available for others visiting Sunapee Harbor.

As long as your event can follow the request I do not need to assign an officer and bill your company. However if there becomes an issue that requires an officer to be at the event I will have to send a bill.

My biggest issue will be the parking for loading and unloading and traffic issues please stress to your artists that this needs to be an expedited event for them to spend the least amount time on the roadway.

As I explained to you the first few weeks in July are the busiest of our season for Sunapee Harbor and my staff.

#### WARRANTY DEED

THE TOWN OF SUNAPEE, a municipal corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of New Hampshire with a mailing address of 23 Edgemont Road, Sunapee, New Hampshire 03782, acting by and through its duly authorized Board of Selectmen ("Town"), for consideration paid, grants to the Sunapee New Hampshire Historical Society, Inc., a non-profit organization duly organized under the laws of the State of New Hampshire with a mailing address of PO Box 501, Sunapee, NH 03782 ("Society"), WITH WARRANTY COVENANTS, the following property located in Sunapee, Sullivan County, New Hampshire:

A certain tract or parcel of land with buildings thereon situated at 542 Route 11 in Sunapee, County of Sullivan, identified in the Town's tax records as Tax Map/Lot 129/77, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the south west corner bound of land of Edward S. Perkins on the north line of highway leading from Sunapee Lower Village to the lake;

Thence westerly on the north line of highway leading from Sunapee Lower Village to the lake;

Thence westerly on north line of highway one hundred forty (140) feet more or less to stone post on town land set in ground;

Thence northerly on Town of Sunapee land ninety (90) feet, more or less to stone set in ground to land of Charles Muzzey;

Thence easterly on said Muzzey's land one hundred ten (110) feet, more or less to land of Edward S. Perkins:

Thence south easterly on land of said Perkins eighty-seven (87) feet, more or less; and

Thence southerly on said Perkin's land one hundred twenty (120) feet, more or less to bound began at.

Meaning and intending to convey all and the same premises described in the deed from George F. and Ella O. Peabody, husband and wife, to the Town of Sunapee, dated October 30, 1923, and recorded in the Sullivan County Registry of Deeds at Volume 213, Page 540.

Reserving to the Town an easement for a time capsule that is presently buried in the front lawn of the subject property; said easement to allow the Town, with two business days notice, when it deems it necessary to enter the subject property to excavate the time capsule, and to re-bury it in the same or similar location; following the excavation and/or possible re-burial, the Town shall repair the property as close as reasonably possible to its pre-excavation or pre-burial condition. The Town shall communicate the location of the time capsule to the Society, and the Society, its heirs and assigns, agrees that no structure on or use of the property herein shall frustrate the purpose of this easement.

The Town conveys the property described herein subject to the following restrictions: no change in either the facade or the landscaping except for modest pruning of the bushes, other routine maintenance, and removal of the "Abbott Library" exterior signage; the red brick with white trim exterior design and appearance shall remain and may be maintained or repaired as needed; the entry portico steps and entry lawn are critical to the architectural design and shall also be maintained and kept in good working order.

The land and buildings conveyed herein were the subject of a certain court action, *Town of Sunapee & Town of Sunapee Library Trustees v. Attorney General, Director of Charitable Trusts*, 5<sup>th</sup> Circuit-Probate Division-Newport, Docket No. 320-2016-EQ-00153. By Notice of Decision dated May 25, 2016, the court granted the requested Petition for Cy Pres.

The Town is exempt from the real estate transfer tax pursuant to RSA 78-B:2, II.

We do not have a policy in Auburn Donna, but the practice is that political signs are not allowed on public property such as Town Hall, parks, etc. We have only had one candidate come in and formally ask the BOS about putting a sign up in front of the Town Hall (which is on a state road, so a wide ROW), and the BOS flat out said no.

It is our practice to remove political signs that appear on Town property (again, Town Hall. Library, parks, Safety Complex, etc.), but not generally from ROW throughout the community.

Our governing boards have long thought they would err on the side of caution to ensure it did not appear the town government was supporting any candidates for office in any election.

So how appropriate on election day. Our police chief came to the board last night and wants some clarity. Apparently the SOS says most towns should adopt a policy. Section 664:17 is the political advertising statute. It is the ROW part that is the problem. We have town owned properties like the town office, information booth, transfer station that has political signs show up and be placed in the ROW. The statute says the property owner must give permission. The town who would be the property owner for those ROW's has not given permission but it has just happened over time. Now they are getting closer and closer to the entrance of the police station and highway garage and some think it appears that those entities support whoever's sign is placed. I know not a new subject.

However our board asked me to see if other towns had policies/ordinance or did they just allow all the signs if they didn't interfere with traffic on Town owned property ROW's

# Town of Fremont NH Information regarding Political Advertising Signs

NH RSA 664:17 Placement and Removal of Political Advertising:

"No political advertising shall be placed on or affixed to any public property including highway rights-of-way or private property without the owner's consent. The candidate shall remove all political advertising no later than the second Friday following the election unless the election is a primary and the advertising concerns a candidate who is a winner in the primary. Signs shall not be placed on or affixed to utility poles or highway signs. Political advertising may be placed within State-owned rights-of-way as long as the advertising does not obstruct the safe flow of traffic and the advertising is placed with the consent of the owner of the land over which the right-of-way passes.

No person shall remove, deface, or knowingly destroy any political advertising which is placed on or affixed to public property or any private property except the owner of the property, persons authorized by the owner of the property, or a law enforcement officer removing improper advertising. State, City, or Town Maintenance or Law Enforcement Personnel may remove political advertising placed on or affixed to any public property. Political advertising removed prior to election day by state, city, or town maintenance or law enforcement personnel shall be kept for one week at a place designated by the state, city, or town so that the candidate may retrieve the items.

As it pertains to the highway right-of- way provision, the Fremont Board of Selectmen, after consultation with the Fremont Town Clerk and Moderator, has outlined the following guidelines:

- 1. No political signs shall be placed on Town Property outside of the road right-of-way.
- 2. Within the road right-of-way [generally 13 feet from the edge of pavement or travel way], signs may only be placed with the direct abutter's permission. This refers to the abutter on that side of the street.
- 3. At the polling entrance, unattended political signs may be placed only on the actual polling day during open polling hours [7:00 am to 8:00 pm]; and only in the designated area as determined by the Moderator. The designated area will be appropriately marked and place in an area that will not obstruct or hinder the safe flow of traffic. (This designated area allows the Town of Fremont to abide by the Attorney General's rules). Signs shall be removed immediately following the election.
- 4. A candidate or the candidate's representative must attend all other signs which will be permitted in an area designated by the Moderator in accordance with RSA 659:43.

If you have any polling-related questions, please call the Town Clerk at 603 895 8693.

The Town of Fremont designates the Fremont Safety Complex as the storage location for any political advertising signs removed for improper placement; or those found after having been displaced by wind or weather conditions. Contact the Town Clerk for further information.

This is a comparision between the 2018 General Fund Operating Budget Personnel Cost and the 2019 Proposed Budget Personnel Costs. The General Fund is comprised of all Budgets except the Hydro Fund and the Water & Sewer Fund. These are Enterprise Funds, which means that they pay for themselves and do not impact the Tax Rate. When you compare the 2018 Budget to the 2019 Budget with 52 weeks for an apples to apples comparision you find that the total increase is \$100,288.82. This represents the 2.2% COLA the 2.5% or 1.75% Step increases, changes in Census, Changes in rates such as Worker's Compensation Rates and NH Retirement system rates. When you compare the 2018 Budget to the 2019 Proposed Budget which includes 53 pay weeks the Total Increase is \$143,441.48 This includes the extra weeks pay for all employees, 2.2%COLA, Step increase and changes in rates. If you compare the 2019 Proposed General Fund Budget to the same with only 52 pay weeks you find a difference of \$43,152.66. This represents the total cost of the fifty-third pay week. The added wage affects the cost of the other roll ups as well.
