Motion: It was moved, seconded and approved to accept the minutes of the October 24, 2018, meeting.

Motion: It was moved and seconded to request that the Sunapee Board of Selectmen approve and amount of \$893.03 to pay Stone Vault for engraving the granite stone placed over the time capsule. Approved unanimously.

Motion: It was moved and seconded to request that the Sunapee Board of Selectmen approve an expense of \$30.00 to repay Megan Leo for a license plate that was not received. After a short discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

Kathy updated the committee on the web site and commemorative item sales. The Pay Pal account will be closed as of December 15 in order to have time to prepare end of year reports. All unsold commemorative items will be given to Sunapee (Town Offices) and will be sold from there by the town. The Committee will no longer be involved with the sales. Committee members who have items should get them to the town offices.

Sharon Parsons updated the Committee on discussions with the Abbott Library about giving patrons access to celebration photographs. The library is willing to do this and also suggested having the photographs available on their web site. After some discussion about privacy rights and conditions of use, the Committee decided to defer discussion to the January meeting. The next meeting of the Committee will be Wednesday, January 9, 2019, at 7PM, at the Town Offices Building. The Chair was reminded to make sure someone attending would be able to open the door.
