• Call to order at 6:34p.m.

- Executive Session MGL c.30A, §21, ¶3 & ¶7 read by Chair, Mr. Bergeron. Declaration made. Will return to open session. Motion by Mr. Pierce to enter into executive session, 2nd by Mr. Fydenkevez. Roll Call Bergeron-yes, Fydenkevez-yes, Pierce-yes. Vote 3-0. Reconvened in open session at 7:10pm.
- Summer Roads Update- George Emery, Highway Superintendent-Claybrook Road getting work done with Chapter 90 funds. Needs full depth reclamation. Will have bottom surveyed to see if they can widen it a little bit. Several roads will get oil/stone and shimming. Catch basin cleaning will be done. Guard rail will be going in with pothole money. All pothole money work must be done by July 30th. Mountain roads need to be looked at and cleaned out. Discussion regarding catch basin cleaning; storm drain rebuilding; crack sealing. Mr. Emery-not enthusiastic about use of crack seal. May try it on a few roads to assess how effective it is. Street sign replacement schedule. Discussion regarding shared bucket truck with Deerfield and Whately. Whately and Sunderland town meetings voted funds. Deerfield Highway Superintendent will use operating budget money. Some tree work being done on Main Street. Discussion regarding tree on Reservation Road and the Mount Toby house to be demolished soon. Discussion regarding working with UMass Dept. of Environmental Conservation on a Main Street tree inventory and condition assessment.
- Interim Town Administrator- Discussion with candidate Wendy Foxmyn. Ms. Foxmyn gave an introduction. Discussion regarding sub-regional and regional collaboration, transition in position, value of local knowledge and years of experience, demands on town government; communication with legislators, residents, and neighboring communities, and town operations. Mr. Bergeron discussed next steps. Ms. Foxmyn only candidate recommend to come in at this time. Motion by Mr. Fydenkevez to enter into Interim Town Administrator salary/contract negotiations, 2nd by Mr. Pierce. Vote 3-0. Mr. Bergeron will meet with Ms. Foxymn tomorrow at 5:30pm for an initial discussion.
- Public Comment- School Street property exchange for river access Community Pathways. Rock Warner and Nancy Pick gave overview & update. Maintenance easements might be required. Discussion regarding working with present land owner. Good to clarify ownership and appropriate language governing control of property to the river. Mr. Fydenkevez-would like to address whole initiative (all School Street actions) as a package. Town Administrator to get budget numbers for surveyor and legal counsel. Follow up for June 1st agenda.
- May 11, 2015 Minutes- Motion by Mr. Pierce to approve May 11, 2015 minutes, 2nd by Mr. Fydenkevez. Vote 3-0.
- Town Administrator Updates- Solar project, North Main Street reconstruction engineering proposals, Public Safety Complex cooling system replacement IFB, end-of-year work.
- Board of Selectmen Updates- Mr. Bergeron-120 North Main Street-Berkshire Design preparing scenarios that take wet areas on the property into consideration. Market studies are ongoing. Discussion regarding need for senior housing; economic viability and suitable housing development for the site.
- General Accounting and Finance Policies and Procedures Amendments- Motion to accept policy with amendments by Mr. Fydenkevez, 2nd by Mr. Pierce. Vote 3-0.
- Board of Selectmen FY16 Committee Reappointments- Motion by Mr. Fydenkevez to accept slate (attached), 2nd by Mr. Pierce. Vote 3-0. Mr. Fydenkevez-suggest changing Sunderland Telecommunications Committee to advisory ad-hoc group.
- Part-Time Police Officer Resignation- Motion to accept resignation of Charles Valencik by Mr. Pierce, 2nd by Mr. Fydenkevez. Vote 3-0.
