M. Briggs explained the complaint that came in from DEP. This is why he was issued an Enforcement Order. Mr. Briggs asked "Why is there this second complaint after he came in a year ago on a first complaint to fix this area?"

N. McLaughlin explained that he received the ok to finish the work that he started last year. This year he has been placing heavy rocks on the top of the banking and below it to keep the erosion under control. He couldn't finish the work last year and that is what he is doing now. Some of the rocks rolled down the hill and he had to use equipment to bring the rocks back up. He also drove it to his neighbors to help out.

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- M. Briggs questioned the bulldozing of the resource area which is is within the 200' jurisdictional area of the stream. He suggested that a few of the excess stones be put along the lower edge of the resource area, so no one will go in that area with equipment in the future.
- B. Faneuf showed the stream and wetland area on the GIS maps.

On May 13th A. Aubin shut down the well digging due to no replication being done and no notification to Conservation.

J. Sheehan explained that they did not do the replication area before they started the construction on this site. They should have put this in five months ago before the drain was installed.

Person #1 replied they put the drain in under the driveway so that all they had to do was the replication. They want to give the Commission their assurance that in two weeks they will get the replication in.

- B. Faneuf and Ms. Sharkey will do the site visit for the replication area and meet with the contractor. There are a few things that should be done before construction starts. They should stake the boundary area so the contractor knows where to go, and the erosion controls should be put in. The Commission is not using haybales any longer. If they use straw wattles it needs to be burlap, not plastic and they should call for an inspection.
- M. Briggs said they need a deep sump so nothing goes into the vernal pool area.
