Discussion was about **530 Central Turnpike** driveway issue to check with the Planning Board as to the status of this driveway. Mr. Heney would be asked to attend the next meeting for an update of the work that was completed. **6R Torrey Road** – they don't have a trailer permit from the Building Department, however Mr. Couture was ok with it being there while the house is rebuilt as long as they are not living in the trailer, just using it during construction of the new house.

78 Torrey Road – The owners sent in a Plan/Sketch for a log crossing, over the wet areas that they would like to construct for access to the back part of the property. M. Briggs said this plan is ok for this season. However, he suggested that they file an RDA for any future work to be done.

91 Dudley Road – an affidavit was received stating there were no wetlands in the area of work activity.

Site Visits would be done at 15 Torrey Road for C of C and to see if the erosion controls are ready to be removed.

The Board reviewed the Correspondence for 36 Horne Drive, Chapter 91 state license.
