The Public Hearing was opened at 7:00pm. D. Moroney read the hearing notice as it appeared in the Millbury Sutton Chronicle.

The project consists of addressing stormwater drainage and water quality improvements through infiltration swale.

A. Bastoni explained what the state was doing across the entire area along the Marble Pond area along with the four basins that the stormwater drains into.

J. Malloy gave the overview of the area including the 30,00sf and the 200' riverfront area, which is all in the buffer zone. The work would be 80' long and two feet deep and would pick up the water from the four basins. There would be no wetland impacts.

R. Tefft asked for the details on the swale.

G. White explained the details and that the swale would be all grass.

B. Faneuf summarized his site visit report recommends a long term operations O & M be attached to the end of the Order of Conditions with the Special Conditions.
