Fees, S Rice would like the Board to enact Hazardous Materials Regulations, other towns do Hazmat inspections, all businesses should have all MSDS and spill kits according to the chemicals they have on site. He would like to change the menu, but is only allowed to changes certain things according to the landlord. He would like to add cold cuts, maybe a broiled fish dinner. He would like more of a variety; he will not be having

soft serve ice cream. S Rice asks what experience he has, Mr. Kassata tells the Board that he has been a cook for 10 years. 5 of those years as a cook in Burlington, at the Pie Shop Restaurant, and 5 years in Medford. He asks the Board if they would mind if he added more hours to the store, and he would like to be open on Sundays. S Rice informs him that the Board would have no problem with that, but would like to be informed when hours and menu changes are made.
