- 1. Jesse Limanek made a motion to accept the Minutes from April 5, 2017, second by Chief Dennis Towle: vote 7-0.
- 2. Jeffrey McElravy used structural and civil drawings on a PDF to provide a status update to the number of changes made to the original plans. Jeffrey advised that a revised cost estimate will be available for the May 3 meeting. Planning for snow removal is still being reviewed. The location of the driveway onto Central Turnpike has been moved slightly to get it further away from the intersection. The abandoned pipeline should not present any problems. The possible location for a communications tower remains to be determined. There is an issue still to be resolved with the grading adjacent to the wetlands. Solar panels may be located on the carport roof. Jim Smith mentioned the idea of adding windows to the dormers.
- 3. Jim Smith reported that the Board of Selectmen had signed the May 8 Town Meeting Warrant and that the new police station will be Article 15. The Finance Committee is supporting the Article based on the need for a new police station. The purchase of land at Pigeon Hill Cemetery could be used to locate a communications tower.
- 4. Wendy Mead reported that the Police Station Building Committee now has a Facebook page.

- 6. Jesse Limanek made a motion to adjourn @ 7:34, second by Chief Dennis Towle, vote passed 7-0-0.
