- 1. Jesse Limanek made a motion to accept the Minutes from March 22, 2017, second by Chief Dennis Towle: vote 6-0-1.
- 2. Jeffrey McElravy used structural and civil drawings on a PDF to provide a status update to the changes made to the original plans. Matt Salad reviewed the changes to the floor plan of the new station. Jeffrey advised that a considerable amount of additional information along with a "very reliable estimate" will be available for the next meeting. The possible location of solar is being looked into. An access permit will be applied for with Mass. DOT with no issues expected. The HVAC system will be the Variable Air System. The exact location of the communications tower remains to be determined.
- 3. Robert "Nick" Nunnemacher, a member of the public, asked several questions which were addressed by Jeffrey McElvray. Additional discussion concerned the current owner and status of the gas pipeline on the site.
