The first order of business was the approval of minutes from the monthly Sewer Commissioner meeting from January 10, 2017. Larry made a motion, Motion passed 3-0.

- Nick Nunnemacher from 24 Singlerary Ave came in to discuss extension of sewer to center of town.
- Mr. Nunnemacher questioned if town owned properties pay for sewer usage.

- The Whitins Road generator has been finished and paid for through the insurance company.
- Neal would like the sewer secretary to look into the online links and make sure they are current and up to date.


The next order of business: New Business.

- An invoice was presented to the board from Barrows Contracting.
- This invoice is due to sewer coming up from the road on 92 Hartness Road. The work has been completed.
- There have been a few tie-ins in Northbridge since Wal-Mart tied in.


Carl moved to adjourn. Larry seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 2:42 P.M.
