2. Coastal Barrier Resources System Mapping Project

US Fish & Wildlife Service is modernizing and remapping the Coastal Barrier Resources System as an element of coastal resiliency and sustainability associated with the Hurricane Sandy response and recovery effort. The Town owns conserved land within a System Unit (Palmer Pond). As administrators of that land, the Conservation Commission has been asked to confirm classification as a System Unit or Otherwise Protected Areas.

3. Environmental Complaint Submitted to MassDEP
  - a. **6 Connelly Avenue** – Commission to discuss complaint submitted to MassDEP by a Swampscott resident. Complaint states: area bordering a vernal pool was paved over illegal construction is underway, and oil seeps from the ground on abutting properties and has been detected in Fosters Pond, illegal dumping is occurring in the wetland and the contamination seems to reside all along Connolly Ave.
4. Charles Ewing Woods – discuss potential surveying of the conservation land property
