The Committee will hold a public walking tour as an initial review of the potential historic district areas for the Town. The walking tour will proceed as follows:

- a. Leave from Town Hall (main lobby area) 7:10pm
- b. Walk to the intersection of Humphrey St and Redington St
- c. Turn left and walk to the intersection of Redington St and Blaney St
- d. Turn right and walk to the intersection of Blaney St and Rose St
- e. Turn left and walk to the intersection of Rose St and Rockland St
- f. Turn left and walk to the intersection of Rockland St and Redington St
- g. Turn right and walk to the intersection of Redington St and King St
- h. Turn right and walk to the intersection of King St and Greenwood Ave
- i. Turn right and walk to the intersection of Greenwood Ave and Rockland St
- j. Turn right and walk to the intersection of Rockland St and Rose St
- k. Turn left and walk to the intersection of Rose St and Blaney St
- I. Turn right and walk to intersection of Blaney St and Humphrey St
- m. Turn right and return to Town Hall

A final itinerary will be available the night of the meeting at Town Hall.

- 4. Discussion of methodology the HDSC will use to gather data which conforms to the Massachusetts Historic Commission protocol.
- 5. Any new business that may come before the committee.
