	<ol> <li>Establish relationships with statewide historic preservation organizations;</li> </ol>
	6) Consider ways to make preservation bylaw more effective;
	<ol> <li>Research and educate ourselves and the community as to technical and financial resources available for historic preservation; and</li> </ol>
	8) Educate the community as to the importance of historic preservation.
	The Commission agreed to further discuss these goals, and determine appropriate objectives for implementing these goals.
