The committee reviewed and discussed the application for the current Green Communities grant round. Some potential projects would have to be left off of the application, as they would put us over the \$250,000 limit set in the application guidelines. After much discussion it was the opinion of the committee that we should leave out the Hadley school projects as it is likely that building will be razed within five years. In a unanimous vote of members present, the committee decided to include the following projects in the grant application:

Clarke Elementary:

Steam Trap Replacement & Building Envelope – Roof/Wall/Attic insulation

*Stanley Elementary:

Building Envelope – Weatherization

Middle School:

Building Envelope – Weatherization

High School:

Building Envelope – Weatherization

Fire Station:

Building Envelope – Roof/Wall/Attic insulation

Library – HVAC equipment replacement

*Note that the Stanley school will also likely be razed, but the Stanley weatherization project was only \$5,221 so the committee was able to include it and stay below the \$250,000 limit.
