



Dear Mayor Crowley and Members of the Municipal Council,

On March 15, 2011, the Development Impact Review Board met to review the application of Manuel Soares for a live entertainment in conjunction with the existing restaurant at 47-53 Weir Street, Taunton, Ma which requires a Special Permit/ Site Plan Review from the Municipal Council.

In considering the petition, the DIRB familiarized itself with the premises and examined the location, layout and other characteristics.

After reviewing the petition, plans and testimony, the DIRB finds that the petition was formally sufficient and submitted and reviewed in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Zoning Ordinance and that proper notice was given

The DIRB hereby recommends that any approval of this petition by the Municipal Council address the following comments;

Comment #1) There is no site plan to review in that the premises has no off street parking. The minimum parking requirement for the 56 seat restaurant is 29 space and none are provided on site. The Municipal Council must waive this requirement under section 7.3.1 to zero. The DIRB has no issues with this waiver request.

Comment #2) the live entertainment request is restricted to the existing restaurant and does not include the function room at this address

Dear Members of DIRB:

We are in receipt of your letter for the request by the Ugly Duckling Restaurant petition to expand its use to offer live entertainment in their building referred to as 47-53 Weir Street. We have several questions that we would like answered as it is unclear as to the full intentions of this request.

Our questions are as follow:

- 1. What portion of the building will be allowed the "use" of live entertainment? The building address is vague and referred to as 47-53 Weir Street, but the Ugly Duckling Restaurant currently does not occupy all that space. So which address will be allowed that use?
- 2. Is this board and petition only addressing the area of the building known as the "Empire Function Room" and if so, is this request being considered for functions only as it is a function room?

Now we wish to comment and address other area of concerns. My wife Denise and I have owned and operated this location for more than 20 years. During this time, we have watched as this area has grown and become saturated in population and traffic. There is a major concern for parking and lack thereof. We have personally witnessed arguments over people parking on a common basis.

We are concerned that further growth is going to gravely impact public safety and access to this area due to lack of public accessible parking.

This being said, we are in support of our neighbor and colleague as we fully understand how difficult it is in today's economy to survive and continue to support the Municipality of Taunton and its infrastructure, however, we only support this request as an abutter as it pertains and remains as a function room only.

We thank you for the opportunity to be heard, we respectfully request that this letter be read into the DIRB meeting and recorded as part of its minutes and be forwarded to the Municipal Council upon the hearing for the Ugly Duckling.



We have been to the city law office on several occasions requesting information on purchasing this land (which has been owned by the city of Taunton now for over two (2) years) On one trip in we were informed that the city is not interested in selling the land; then on another trip into city hall we were told that the land would be put up to an abutters bid. We asked the law office how the abutters bid worked and what steps are required to place a bid. The office told us that they could not help because that they had no information on how to do this and could not direct us to anyone who could help. We did talk to a couple of city council member and they were able to get us paperwork on how the bidding works, and recommended we contact you.

If we are able to purchase this land it will be use to extend our back yard as open space.
