RE:

School Zones, Barnum & Leddy Schools

The DPW wishes to move flashing SCHOOL ZONE/SPEED LIMIT signs that are currently serving the closed Maxham and Walker Schools, and use them for the Barnum and Leddy schools. In order to facilitate the legal standing of the schools zones, speed regulations must be incorporated into the City's Ordinances. My recommendation for these ordinances are as follows:

BARNUM SCHOOL

Barnum Street, from the intersection of Harrison Avenue, 400 feet easterly, school zone, between the hours of 7:00 am and 8:00 am and 2:00 pm and 3:00 pm during school hours.

At the Barnum School, the DPW intends to replace the existing SCHOOL ZONE/20MPH signs with the flashing signs.

EDWARD F. LEDDY SCHOOL

Because the Leddy school is located at the corner of Somerset Avenue and Second Street, I recommend that a school zone speed limit be imposed on both roadways, as follows:

Somerset Avenue, from a point 400 feet south of Second Street northerly, to a point 200 feet north of Second Street. Second Street, from the intersection of Somerset Avenue, easterly 600 feet, school zone, between the hours of 7:00 am and 8:00 am and 2:00 pm and 3:00 pm during school hours.

School zone speed limits on local roadways need only local approval. MDOT/RVM approval is not required.

Re: Land Swap with Taunton Municipal Airport

Dear Attorney Strojny:

I recently reported to the City Council and the Airport Commission about our discussions earlier this month regarding your client's proposed development abutting the airport. The Airport Commission has raised two additional issues, at least one of which would be of benefit in resolving matters with the regulatory authorities. First of all, the commission notes that there are utilities servicing the airport that run as much as fifteen feet back from the layout of Westcoat Drive. Obviously, your client would not be able to build on these portions of the land, anyway, and the Airport Commission would like either a cession of that portion of the land back to them or an easement over it to maintain the utilities. They made it quite clear that they strongly prefer getting title to that strip back.

The easier and more helpful concession that the commission seeks is the erection of an 8-foot fence along the perimeter of those utilities screening your client's development from Westcoat Drive, essentially extending an existing fence that already extends out from the airport. The Commission says that if that is done, they will consider that they have received fair market value for the property that has been in contention and they will certify so to the state and federal authorities and not seek any monetary concessions.

I thank you for your kind cooperation to date and look forward to hearing further from you.

Dear Mayor Crowley and Municipal Council:

It was requested from this office regarding what money amount was transferred to the General Fund in regards to the City Health Trust.

In the budget process for Fiscal Year 2010, the amount of \$ 1,492,266.58 was included as a transfer from the City Health Trust to use as part of the revenue to support the FY2010 Health Insurance Budget. This was done as this Trust was determined that this Trust was not longer in use for expenses. It was also done after a review of the account by the City Treasurer was done to ensure that the amount in the Trust was in fact the Cities Health Share amount.

This transfer was brought before the City Council during the Supplemental Budget process for vote as an available fund. It was also included in the recap documentation submitted to the State for the setting of the FY2010 Tax Rate. The Department of Revenue reviews all items submitted by the City to be used as available funds, and if they deem that the funds are an unallowable source to be used, then they deny its use, and the City has to either find another source of revenue, or reduce its appropriations by the denied amount. This transfer was allowed, and upon the approval of the City's tax rate in February of 2010, it was included in the journal entries prepared by this office for the inclusion of the FY2010 budget in the general ledger.
