New Balance Reach the Beach Relay


The event begins at Wachussett Mt. and ends at Horseneck Beach which is about 190 miles. There will be 300 teams with a maximum of 12 per team. Each member will run 3 legs of the 36 total through the course. Runners will be released in waves beginning at 7:30 am and ending at 4 pm on Friday May 20th, 2011. The finish line should see the first runners around 11am on Saturday May 21st with the last crossing around 8 pm.

The route in through Taunton would see 300 runners and vans between the hours of 3am and 8am May 21st. The route would leave the town of Norton on S Worcester St. to Worcester St. to Walker St. and continue on to Dighton.

We have had 12 successful similar races in NH and we take care of all the details including EMT's and radio personnel at all TA's and provide insurance which will include the town as well as the transition areas.

Mayor Crowley, Council President Sherry Costa-Hanlon, and

distinguished municipal council members,

I am very disappointed with treasurer Jayne Ross' decision not to grant my request as treasurer of the Taunton Educational Secretaries and Assistants Association to delay union deductions by one week because of the hardship realized by deducting these dues from a 3-day work week.

I will attempt to inform our members of this unfortunate decision as soon as possible. However, when they open their paychecks on Thursday they will realize that my

request was denied.

Since we are not paid for any holidays or Christmas week, it has been very difficult for our membership to get buy on shorted paychecks during the month of January. Four snowdays, the MLK holiday, and a teacher's professional day have created this financial havoc for our members. The treasurer's office has actually granted this request twice before. In 2009 for the week after Thanksgiving I requested that dues not be deducted for 2 weeks because of the short week and my letter of request was read at the City Council meeting and approved. Last December I formally sent a like letter requesting dues be delayed again because of the short week and it was approved.

Apparently, since union dues deductions have been delayed before, I was confident that this could be accomplished

once again.

I have tried to be professional as treasurer of our union in representing our membership, but you must know that dealing with Ms. Ross for many of us city workers is frustrating at best. It is a shame that this couldn't have been approved when this will affect 340 city employees.

I would like to have this email read and discussed at the next council meeting in an effort to reconcile this problem for the future. Our hard working teaching assistants and secretaries in the school system deserve better cooperation from our city administration.
