Chapter 8

Garbage, Trash, and Refuse

Be it ordained by the Municipal Council of the City of Taunton and by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Article I of Chapter 8 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Taunton, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out Section 8-4 and Section 8-5.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.

AN ORDINANCE

Chapter 13

Sec 13-82. Prohibited parking places.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Council of the City of Taunton and by authority of the same as follows:

That Section 13-82 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Taunton, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following:

- Fayette Place, west side and north side running from Fruit Street to Cedar Street.
- Fayette Place, east side running northerly from Fruit Street for one hundred feet.
- Cherry Street, both sides between Floral Street and Winter Street.
- School Street, east side from intersection with Main Street to the intersection with Winter Street.

All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
