

This office is requesting a vote authorizing the filing of municipal liens for unpaid police details.

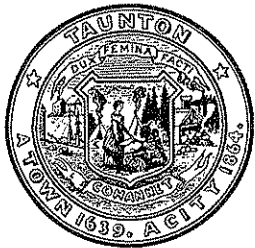

The lighting provided by the Taunton Municipal Lighting Plant at the City of Taunton Public Library has been completed with the following results:

- Two lights on the northeast driveway are fully functional. One is a Floodlight shining in driveway, other is street light.
- Two lights on the northwest driveway were not working, and have been replaced with new lights on 10/5/11. One is a Floodlight shining in driveway, other is street light.
- One light on the southwest corner (Near the Boys Club) is covered with tree branches and will be trimmed on Saturday 10/8, when there are no cars parked underneath the light.

It is our understanding that the lights mounted on the Library Building are the responsibility of the building department. The TMLP is willing to assist the building department as needed if special equipment or manpower is needed. Please ask the building department to contact me if they need any assistance.
