At your request, the following is an update on the upcoming anticipated retirements at the Fire Department;

In anticipation of Leman Padelford's final payment and projecting other retirements for 2011 I requested in my FY11 Budget for retirement expenses a combined amount of \$469,816.10; unfortunately I was only funded for approximately half of that amount.
