

Dear Mr. Marshall,

On behalf of the Taunton Development/MassDevelopment Corporation (TDMDC) and the new Martignetti Building (Sixty Cross Street LLC) to be located in the Miles Standish Industrial Park, Phase 4 we are submitting a request that the DPW Committee of the City Council approve our combined request to enter Charles F. Colton Road to access the utilities and modify the current right-of way pavement in accordance with the construction plans approved by the Taunton Planning Board.

We understand that Charles F. Colton Road is currently under a 5-year moratorium having been accepted in early 2014. TDMDC is constructing the new Dever Drive from Bay Street to Charles F. Colton Road tying in the various utilities to Colton Road and looping them to Bay Street. Sixty Cross Street LLC is modifying the roadway at the intersection of Dever Drive and Charles F. Colton Road to install a roundabout at the request of the City DPW and City Engineer while modifying the original layout of the end of Charles F. Colton Road.

We understand and anticipate that additional requirements will be placed on the final repairs as the utility and roundabout work is completed by the Taunton DPW Director and will comply with them to the fullest, such as cold-planing and paving a distance away from the disturbance.

Thank you very much for your consideration as we move closer to completing the full development of the Miles Standish Industrial Park with our partner, Taunton Development Corporation.

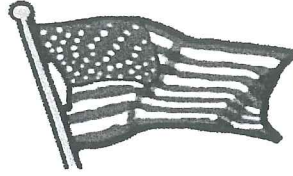

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
