Order for a first reading to be passed to a second reading

Ordered That,

That the City of Taunton appropriate the amount of Two Hundred Seventy Thousand (\$270,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of paying costs of a roof repair/replacement at Galligan School, 15 Sheridan Street, Taunton, MA including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto (the "Project"), which proposed repair project would materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve an asset that otherwise is capable of supporting the required educational program, and for which the City of Taunton may be eligible for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority ("MSBA"), said amount to be expended under the direction of the City of Taunton's Building Committee. To meet this appropriation the Mayor of Taunton is authorized to borrow said amount under M.G.L. Chapter 44, or pursuant to any other enabling authority. The City of Taunton Acknowledges that the MSBA's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any project costs the City of Taunton incurs in excess of any grant that may be approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the City of Taunton; provided that any grant that the City may receive from the MSBA for the project shall not exceed the lesser of (i) 74 percent of eligible, approved project costs, as determined by the MSBA, or (ii) the total maximum grant amount determined by the MSBA; provided that the borrowing authorized pursuant to this order shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement that may be executed between the City of Taunton and the MSBA.

I have recently been contacted by legal counsel for the Taunton Housing Authority with respect to the Hope VI project. It appears that the Housing Authority's title examination has revealed that the City has a legal interest in eleven small lots of land proposed to be part of the project, mostly, if not completely, through the tax taking process.


The Housing Authority requests that the City convey these lots to it for nominal consideration. I have been told that certified professional appraisals of the lots show that they have nominal value. I have requested copies of the appraisals. Attached is map that shows the eleven parcels in question in yellow ink.

The City is authorized under G.L. c.121B, § 23 and G.L. c.30B, § 16 to convey these parcels to the Housing Authority with or without consideration. I respectfully request a meeting with the Committee on Public Property to discuss this matter in further detail.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, Steven Fasolo, of 159 Plain Street, Taunton, Massachusetts as owner of a certain parcel of land shown as Lot 106-169 on a Plan of Land entitled "Plan showing revised location of easement Herbert Street, Taunton, MA prepared by Earth Services Corporation, 198 Crane Avenue South, Taunton, MA 02780 dated January 25, 2012 Scale 1" = 30" due hereby grant to the City of Taunton, a Municipal Corporation, its heirs and assigns with a principal address of City Hall, Taunton, Massachusetts for consideration paid and in full consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the right unto the City of Taunton, its heirs and assigns, forever, to maintain and improve as may be reasonably necessary a certain drainage line and utility easement as originally granted to the City of Taunton by a document entitled "Drainage and Utility Easement dated March 11, 2010 and recorded at the Bristol County Northern District Registry of Deeds on May 14, 2010 at Book 18748, Page 247.
