Dear Council President and Honorable Council Members;

The Taunton Fire Department's SAFER Grant amendment has been approved. This amendment extends the performance period to April 30, 2015. As of November 29, 2014 the City has used \$1,080,038.92 of the allotted federal funds. The full allotment for the grant is 1,345,784.00. The Department is spending approximately \$55,000 a month to cover salaries, health benefits, and pension liabilities for eight City firefighters. At the current rate of expenditure, all the grant funds should be exhausted by the new extension date.

The recent retirements of Private Russell Laine and Private Kirk Wrigley have left the Department with 118 employees. Compliance for our SAFER Grant is 120 employees. For this reason I am asking the Appointing Authority to request a Civil Service Hiring List in order to fill the two vacated spots. Once these two spots are filled we will be in full compliance with the SAFER Grant requirements.
