7.3 OFF-STREET PARKING

7.3.1 PARKING AND LOADING REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Parking Requirements **in all districts except for Central Business District**

Must be provided on-site

Residential Units: 2 spaces per unit

Assisted Living: 1 space per unit

Retail: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 300 square feet over 600 square feet gross floor area

Office: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 500 square feet over 1,000 square feet gross floor area

Industrial uses: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 850 square feet over 1,700 square feet gross floor area

Restaurants, hotel restaurant, cafeteria, hall, club, theater, bowling alley or other place of assembly:

Spaces equal in number to not less than half the seating capacity of each such establishment.

Miscellaneous Uses: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 400 square feet over 800 square feet gross floor area

Minimum Parking Requirements in Central Business District

Residential Units: 1 space per unit

Assisted Living: 1 space per unit

Retail: 1 space per 300 square feet over 2,500 square feet gross floor area

Office: 1 space per 300 square feet over 1,000 square feet gross floor area

Industrial uses: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 850 square feet over 1,700 square feet gross floor area

Restaurants, hotel restaurant, cafeteria, hall, club, theater, bowling alley or other place of assembly: Spaces equal in number to not less than one fourth the seating capacity of each such establishment.

Miscellaneous Uses: 1 space per 400 square feet over 800 square feet gross floor area

Parking Space size: 9 feet by 18 feet, exclusive of driveways

Minimum Aisle Width: The aisle width between parking spaces shall not be less than 22 feet where parking is located on both sides of the aisle.

Special Provisions

An off-street parking area containing one hundred and sixty two (162) square feet of paved surface exclusive of driveways, shall be provided for each motor vehicle stored overnight or longer by an occupant of the premises.

Parking and loading areas are to be graded, subsurfaced, with a non-dusting material, drained and suitably maintained to the extent necessary to avoid nuisance of dust, erosion, or any water flow onto streets or adjoining properties.

A parking area shall not be designed to interfere with loading or unloading zones, access driveways, or egress and ingress to the site.

No loading platform or receiving door shall be located in any front yard, or on the street side of any retail store or other commercial building except a gasoline filling station.

In the Central Business District, for buildings in existence in their current size and bulk as of January 1, 2016, off-street parking requirements may be satisfied if an off-street municipal parking lot exists within 500 feet of the proposed use.

In the Business District and Central Business District parking may be waived or reduced by the Special Permit or Site Plan Review Granting Authority.

In Industrial Districts the following areas may be excluded in figuring the gross floor area: hallways, lobbies, boiler rooms and other unoccupiable space which shall be determined by the Building Commissioner or City Planner.

Mobile Homes

Section 11.1.3.3 Density of Use

There shall be no more than six (6) mobile home units with accessories per acre, exclusive of park and access roads and the area to be set aside for the use of recreation, service, and other permanent facilities. There shall be at least as fifty (50) foot frontage on all mobile home lots.

The occupied area of a mobile home lot shall not exceed thirty-five (35%) percent of the lot area.

Mobile homes shall not be located closer than ten (10) feet to the nearest ~~mobile home lot line or~~ park street; and no mobile home accessory building closer than five (5) feet to ~~that lot line or a~~ park street. **In addition, mobile homes shall be located at least 15 feet from abutting mobile homes and mobile home accessory buildings shall be located at least 10 feet from abutting mobile homes.**

Each mobile home shall be located with at least a forty (40) foot set back from any park property boundary ~~abutting a public street or highway.~~

Special Flood Hazard Districts

13.8.1.11 **New construction or substantial reconstruction on lots where a Special Flood Hazard District encroaches, shall show on the permit plan the limits of said flood zone along with its base flood elevation. Upon completion, an Elevation Certificate (FEMA Form 086-0-33, or latest version), properly completed, sealed and signed, must be submitted along with the as-built site plan, before a Certificate of Occupancy is issued.**

Dear Mayor Hoye:

I would like to take this opportunity to inform you that the Office of Economic and Community Development (OECD) has completed work on the guidelines and application related to your proposed Downtown Rent Rebate Program and is ready to move forward with the implementation of this exciting initiative.

As you know, the Downtown Rent Rebate Program will provide a rent subsidy for a two year period to a new, private-sector business locating within the boundaries of the Downtown Business Improvement District. The first year subsidy will be up to \$5.00 per square foot and the second year subsidy will be up to \$2.50 per square foot. The maximum total subsidy per business will be \$5,000 for the first year and \$2,500 the second year. Therefore, to fund the program for the remainder of this fiscal year, I am respectfully requesting that \$15,000 be set aside.

OECD is excited about this initiative and believes that it will serve as an important incentive in the City's continuing effort to attract new businesses and investment to the downtown area. We have enjoyed working with you in the development of this program and look forward making it a major success.

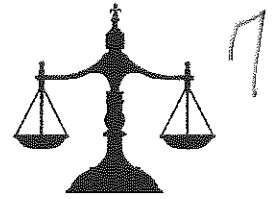


Dear Mayor Hoye and Members of the Municipal Council:

I was recently asked to provide a listing of our vehicle fleet. Attached please find the vehicle list from our 2015-2016 insurance policy indicating a total of 316 vehicles. Please note that since July 1, 2015, we have added approximately five vehicles and removed six, for a total of 315 vehicles.

Additionally, please be advised that we did a vehicle audit in 2013 with our insurance agent, HUB International. As a result of that audit, we removed 107 vehicles from our policy that were either no longer in use or owned by the City, leading to a savings on the City's insurance premium of \$46,772.00. We continue to perform this audit on a monthly basis with one final audit at the end of the fiscal year to ensure that every vehicle is accounted for.

This is as a result of a comprehensive motor vehicle audit undertaken by our new Risk Manager Susan Barber, our new insurance consultant Bradley Smith, and our new insurance broker, HUB International.

It appears that, for years prior to the involvement of Ms. Barber and HUB International, the City had been continuously listing for insurance purposes (and paying to have insured) motor vehicles that the City no longer uses or even still possesses. A total of one hundred seven (107) vehicles were eventually removed from the policy. It is unclear to me why this effort was not undertaken by prior City officials and the prior broker.

I am submitting a request for the Municipal Council to select Integrity Testing to conduct an assessment center for the ranks of Sergeant and Captain based upon the results of the October 2015 police promotional examinations. We solicited bids from four established and Human Resource Division approved assessment centers and received responses from two of them. Based upon review by the Command Staff, Integrity is recommended because lower cost involved. I have attached Captain David Warish's recommendations regarding this.

Badgequest: \$12,998.00

Chief Walsh,

We have received two written proposals regarding the Assessment Center testing for the positions of Captain, and Sergeant (copies of each proposal attached). The proposals were from Badgequest Inc. from Plymouth MA., and Integrity Testing out of Tewksbury MA.

Within their proposals each company provided their respective histories, a list of references, identified assessors they utilize, outlined their scope of services, and provided a price for doing each rank individually, as well as combined. Both companies seem to be reputable, have experienced and highly qualified assessors, and provide a similar scope of services.


The main differences between the two are longevity, and price. Badgequest has been in business since 2001 and thus provided a much longer list of references dating back to its inception in 2001. Integrity Testing was founded in 2012 and started its Assessment Center testing in 2013. With regards to pricing Integrity Testing submitted a bid of \$9,540 to conduct both the Captain, and Sergeant assessments. The Badgequest bid was for \$12,998 to do both, for a difference of \$3,458. To perform the tests individually Integrity proposed \$5,200 for Captain, and \$5,400 for Sergeant. Badgequest proposed \$6,900 each for Captain and Sergeant.

Since both companies are reputable, provide similar testing procedures, and have assessors who have been approved through the Massachusetts HRD, the pricing seems to be the biggest difference between the two. Based on this I would have to recommend Integrity Testing to be hired to conduct both the

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Captain, and Sergeant Assessment Centers. Their bid of \$9,540 was \$3,458 lower than Badgequest.

FIRST AMENDMENT

This First Amendment is to the Memorandum of Understanding Between The Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe ("Tribe") And City Of Taunton, Massachusetts ("City"), For The Implementation Of The Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA"), Dated May 17, 2012 (the "MOU") entered into between the Tribe and City on November 12, 2015. This First Amendment shall go into effect on the date set forth herein below. The Parties agree as follows:

1. This First Amendment is for the purpose of, and this purpose only, of amending Paragraph 5 of the MOU to extend the duration of the MOU for six (6) months. Except as set forth in this Amendment, all other provisions of the MOU remain in full force and effect in accordance with its terms. If there is conflict between this amendment and the MOU, the terms of this amendment will prevail.

2. The MOU shall be in effect for a period of six (6) months, that is, up to and including August 10, 2016, from the effective date of this First Amendment, subject to extension by further written agreement between the Parties pursuant to Paragraph 10 of the MOU.


I recently purchased a home at 84 Hillside Dr, at the unpaved end of a fairly steep road. I have been informed that Hillside Drive was accepted as a street by the City Engineering Department on April 12, 2011. **Much sincere appreciation** to the road crews who have sanded and plowed this season- the road has been promptly cleared during inclement weather this winter. As a career professional Fire Alarm Operator for the City of Brockton, it is essential that I be able to get to work, no matter the weather and road conditions: so far, so good.

The purpose of this letter is to request that Hillside Drive be added to any existing list of proposed streets for paving, to extend the paved section of road from its current termination point, leading up to and in front of my property. We anticipate a future garage addition and the paving of our driveway, and continuation of the paved road would be greatly appreciated. I have spoken to the neighbors who abut the termination point of the road; they are in full agreement that paving the end of the road is desired. If there is a formal process I need to follow to make this request, please let me know ASAP and I will begin the process.

In the meantime, with reference to the unpaved section of Hillside Dr., one unavoidable problem is that the road has become badly rutted due to the plowing equipment. I am well aware that we have many more weeks of winter weather ahead, and that road conditions will continue to vary. 

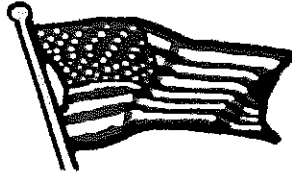
